- 3:00 Market closes
- 3:15 Meet with team to review performance
- 3:45 Review personal trades, record facts in journal
- 4:00 Begin preparation for next day

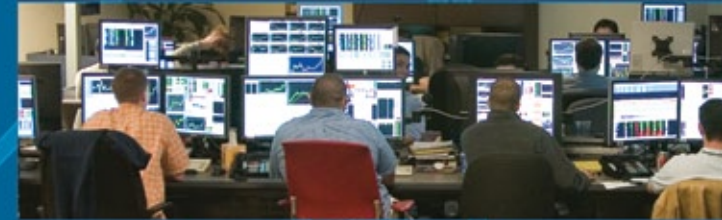
